Texture Mesh

Permanent Ink Pen

DecoArt Acrylic Matte Finish

Snow White, Espresso, Foliage Green, Santa Red, Antique Maroon, Soft Black, Lamp Black, French Mauve, Taffy Cream, Spice Pumpkin, Winter Blue, Williamsburg Blue, Deep Midnight Blue, Lavender, Fawn, Blue Chiffon

Brushes

Black Gold by Dynasty

Series# 206S Shader: 2, 6, 8, 10, 12

Series# 206A Angular Shader: 1/2"

Stencil Brush or Dry Brush

Painting Instructions

Lightly spray the tin with matte sealer. Base the rectangle with Winter Blue. Pounce the top of the shape with Blue Chiffon and the bottom of the shape with Williamsburg Blue. Shade the shape with Nightfall. Shade the darker part with Deep Midnight Blue. Add the snowflakes with Snow White.

Snowman – Base the snowman with Snow White. Shade with Fawn. Dry brush the cheeks with French Mauve. Add highlight dots with Snow White. The eyes and mouth are dots of Lamp Black. The nose is Burnt Orange. The scarf and mittens are based with Santa Red and shade with Antique Maroon. The white lines on the mittens are Snow White. The green stripes on scarf and mittens are Foliage Green. The orange stripes are Spice Pumpkin and the yellow are Taffy Cream. The fringe is Spice Pumpkin and Santa Red. The hat is based with Lavender and shaded with Deep Midnight Blue. The hatband is based with Santa Red and shaded with Antique Maroon. The stripes on the hat are Spice Pumpkin and Taffy Cream. The white dots and texture pattern are Snow White. Add the piles of snow with Snow White. The red heart is Santa Red with a Snow White dot. The button on the snowman is based with Lavender. Use a stylus to add design in the middle with Snow White paint. The arms are Sable Brown and shaded with Espresso. Shade around the snowman with Williamsburg Blue. Shade around the rectangle and extended scarf with Soft Black.

Lettering – Base the word with Soft Black. Move the stencil to the left and up. Base the letters with Lavender. Shade around letters with Williamsburg Blue. Add snow piles and dots with Snow White.

Add any additional snowflakes and larger dots around the pail with Snow White. The purple dots are Lavender. Outline the rectangle with Snow White wavy lines. The top and bottom edges of the pail are Snow White. Spray with matter sealer.



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
