Stencils and Stamp included in your kit

DecoArt Acrylic Matte Finish

## Palette-DecoArt Americana

Snow White, Lamp Black, Indian Turquoise, Lavender, Burnt Orange, Deep Midnight Blue, Fawn, Slate Grey, Blue Harbor, Foliage Green, French Mauve, Sable Brown, Burnt Umber

## Brushes - Black Gold by Dynasty

Series# 206S Shader: 2,6,10

Series# 206FW Flat Glaze: 3/4"

Series# 206A Angular Shader: 1/2"

Series#206L Liner: 1, 2

Series#206MSC Mini Script Liner: 20/0

Stencil Brush or Dry Brush

## Painting Instruction

Base the board with Blue Harbor. Slip slap Foliage Green and Indian Turquoise in the middle of surface. Blend in with the Blue Harbor on the outside. Shade the edges with Deep Midnight Blue. Stamp the musical notes image with Lamp Black.

Base the Snowman with Snow White and shade with Fawn. The sweater is based with Foliage Green and the scarf is Indian Turquoise. Shade both with Deep Midnight Blue. Add dots and lines with Snow White, Indian Turquoise and Deep Midnight Blue on the sweater. The scarf has lines of Snow White and Deep Midnight Blue. The hat is based with Lamp Black and highlighted with Snow White. The arms are based with Sable Brown and shaded with Burnt Umber. The snow on the hat, arms and ground is Snow White.

Dry brush the cheeks on the snowman with French Mauve. Shade with Deep Midnight Blue around the snowman.

Add the nose with Canyon Orange and shade with Burnt Umber. Outline the nose and add details with diluted Soft Black. The eyes and mouth are Lamp Black and the highlight dots on the cheeks are Snow White.

Lettering – Base with Slate Grey. Move the letters to the left and up and repeat with Indian Turquoise. Tape off the upper third of the letters and pounce with Snow White. Tape off the bottom third and pounce with Deep Midnight Blue. The white dots are Snow White.

Snowflakes – Fill the open background with Snow White snowflakes and dots.

Use a permanent ink pen for the outline and detail.

Finish – Spray with acrylic matte finish. Add ribbons and/or hanger as desired.
