Stencil Brush or Dry Brush

Series#206L Liner: 1, 2

Painting Instructions

Tree - Base the tree Foliage Green. Add fine lines with Avocado, Matcha Green and Snow White. You can use a rake, Fandango, Wisp or liner brush to apply the paint. Shade the edges with Avocado. Add snow by pouncing Snow White along each section of tree. Shade underneath snow With Avocado. Add snowflakes and dots with Snow White.

Lettering - Base with Black Forest Green and add white dots with Snow White.

Snowman - Base with Snow White and shade with Indian Turquoise. Add the scarf and earmuffs with Indian Turquoise and shade with Deep Midnight Blue. Highlight with Snow White. The connector for the earmuffs is based with Slate Grey. Shade underneath the connector with Avocado. Add the pink stripes on the scarf with Cactus Flower and shade with Wild Berry. Add white lines with Snow White. The fringe on the scarf is made up of lines of Deep Midnight Blue and Indian Turquoise. Dry brush the cheeks with Cactus Flower. The eyes and mouth are Lamp Black. Add a blue eyesight on the eyes with Indian Turquoise. Add the highlight dots in the eyes and on the cheeks with Snow White. The mouth and eyebrows are Lamp Black. The coal buttons are also Lamp Black. Highlight with Snow White. Shade around the coal with Indian Turquoise. The arms are based with Sable Brown and shaded with Burnt Umber.

Fox - Base with Burnt Orange and shade with Burnt Umber. The face, belly and tip of tail are based with Bleached Sand and shade with Fawn. Highlight with Snow White. The inner ears, nose, eyes, eyebrows are Burnt Umber. The arms and feet are Soft Black. Add the blue scarf with Indian Turquoise and shade with Deep Midnight Blue. The lines are based with Wild Berry. The hearts are Snow White. The red scarf is based with Santa Red and shade with Antique Maroon. The white lines are Snow White.

Moose - Base with Sable Brown and shade with Burnt Umber. Dry brush the cheeks and ears with Cactus Flower. Dry brush the belly lightly with Toffee. The antlers are based with Toffee and shaded with Sable Brown. Highlight the antlers with Snow White. The muzzle is based with Toffee and shaded with Sable Brown. Highlight the muzzle with Snow White. The nostrils and eyebrows are Burnt Umber. The eyes and hooves are

Soft Black. Add arms with Sable Brown and the hooves are Burnt Umber. The scarf is based with Wild Berry and shaded with Antique Maroon. The dots are Snow White and the lines are Indian Turquoise.

Raccoon - Base the raccoon with Slate Grey and shade with Soft Black. The belly is based with Snow White and shaded with Soft Black. The muzzle is based with Grey Sky and shaded with Soft Black. The mask is based with Lamp Black. The top of highlight on the mask is a line of Snow White. The eyes are Snow White with Lamp Black dots. The arms are Slate Grey with Lamp Black hands. The tail has lines of Lamp Black. The feet are Lamp Black. The scarf is based with Santa Red and shade with Soft Black. The white lines are Snow White.

Finish - Pounce additional snow at the base as desired. Spray with a matte finish.
